

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 16558, FILED BY EARLE F. PANKOST TO APPROPRIATE WATER FROM AN UNNAMED SPRING IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEVADA.)

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R U L I N G

General:

Application No. 16558 was filed on June 10, 1955, to appropriate 0.15 c.f.s. of water within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., for Quasi-Municipal (Subdivision) purposes.

90 A protest to the granting of this application was filed on September 22, 1955, by D. W. Park.

A field investigation of this application was made on October 14, 1960. The spring at its closest point is located approximately 1700 feet from the Smalls' (Edgewood) Creek channel. It flows in a northwesterly direction down a small canyon for approximately 500 feet and disappears. The spring was flowing 0.02 c.f.s. and there is no direct contribution from this source into the Smalls' (Edgewood) Creek stream system.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 16558 is herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued under this application in the amount of 0.02 c.f.s. when the following requirements have been complied with:

- (a) The applicant must obtain approval of his subdivision plan from all interested State and county agencies;
- (b) The approved subdivision plan must be submitted to this Office together with the statutory permit fees.
