Protests to the granting of the application were filed on September 10, 1954, by August Bunkowski and Smith Brothers on grounds that their Taylor Grazing Range in the service area would be adversely affected. An informal protest was received on October 14, 1954, by Great Western Aggregates, Inc., on grounds they were the owners of land on which the water under this application was to be appropriated.

Upon investigation it was found that the applicant has an individual range allotment in the service area under the application.

RULING

The protests to the granting of this application are herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not be detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued under said application on receipt of the statutory permit fee.
