R U L I N G

General:

Application 20875 was filed on November 30, 1962, by John Uhart, Jeanette Uhart, John Uhalde and Marie Uhalde for 0.10 c.f.s. of the waters of Cedar Hill Canyon Springs to be diverted within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 20, T. 17 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M. The water is to be used for stock watering (a fraction of 2500 head of sheep) and the place of use is located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

A protest to the granting of Application 20875 was filed on April 10, 1962, by the Virginia City Water Company. The grounds were that the protestant has for a period of more than nine years used the waters of said spring for municipal purposes and that there is no remaining unappropriated water.

A field investigation was made on October 25, 1963.

The records in the office of the State Engineer do not show any existing rights on the source. The Virginia City Water Company does not have a prior right on the source by virtue of any application filed in the office of the State Engineer and there is unappropriated water at this source.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application 20875 is herewith overruled on the grounds that there is unappropriated water in the source, and that the granting thereof will not be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
