General:

Application 22264 was filed September 28, 1964 by Wynona K. Watson for permission to appropriate 5.4 c.f.s. of the waters of an underground source at a point within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.10 N., R.57 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 33 bears N.45°00' E., 70.7 feet to irrigate 320 acres in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 33, T.10 N., R.57 E., M.D.B.&M. during the period January 1 to December 31 of each year. Domestic use of water included in this application.

The application was legally published in the Tonopah Times-Bonanza and Goldfield News, a weekly newspaper printed and published in Tonopah, Nye County, Nevada.

This application was filed in connection with Desert Land application (Nev.-061367) with the U. S. Bureau of Land Management, Nevada Land Office, Reno, Nevada.

On reply to our letter of January 17, 1966, the U. S. Bureau of Land Management informed this office by its letter of January 24, 1966 that this entry was rejected and closed August 31, 1965.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of application 22264 for the use of water on land not owned or controlled by the applicant on which applicant plans to place the water to beneficial use, would be detrimental to the public welfare.


RULING

Application 22264 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant does not have control of the land on which

the applicant plans to place the water to beneficial use, and that the granting of the application would be detrimental to the public welfare.
