FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Terry Roach in the Office of the State Engineer on September 24, 1993 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 12252 was issued to Terry Roach for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on September 27, 1993. References were received from four of the requests. The applicant was notified on September 27, 1993 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 15, 1993 at 11:30 A.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada.¹ The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. The Board found that the applicant did not have sufficient knowledge of the Regulation and recommended that he be retested in January, 1994.¹

The applicant was notified on December 17, 1993 by certified mail to appear before the Board on January 14, 1994, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. He telephoned the State Engineers' Office on January 13, 1994 to cancel his examination and request to be examined in April.¹

The applicant was again notified on March 15, 1994, by certified mail to appear before the Board on April 15, 1994 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. He telephoned the State Engineer's Office on April 11, 1994 to cancel his examination and requested to be examined in July.¹

The applicant was notified on June 23, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Board on July 14, 1994 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada and was advised in this letter that if he cancelled this examination date, he would be noticed once more for examination, and if he cancelled that examination, the Board would consider denial of his license application. He telephoned the State Engineers' Office on July 11, 1994 to cancel his examination.¹

The applicant was notified on September 12, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Board on October 14, 1994 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. He was advised in this letter that if he cancelled this examination (the 4th) the Board would recommend that his application be denied. He telephoned September 28, 1994 and advised that he was not going to take the test for well drillers.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested for examination. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Terry Roach on October 14, 1994.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Terry Roach is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
