RULING

FINDING OF FACTS

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was filed by Brain Laws in the Office of the State Engineer on April 26, 1988, together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 9183 was issued to Brain Laws for said filing fee.

Requests for five (5) references were mailed on April 26, 1988. A response was received from two (2) of the individuals. The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 4, 1988.


CONCLUSIONS

The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board for an oral interview on May 19, 1988. The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommends denial of the application of Brain Laws.

RULING

The application of Brain Laws is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
