RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Jeffrey Alan Huddy in the office of the State Engineer on March 25, 1993 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 11745 was issued to Terracon Consultants Western, Inc. for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on June 25, 1993 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 16, 1993 at 8:00 A.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Jeffrey Alan Huddy on July 16, 1993.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Jeffrey Alan Huddy is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
