Dear Mr. Quinn:

As required under the "State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, Regulations for Drilling Water Wells", Western Technologies Inc. (WTI) is making this report regarding the abandonment of two monitoring wells at 1100 North Main Street. The monitoring wells were installed by WTI in November 1988 for environmental purposes. The wells were installed for SERCON, 2146 South Highland Drive, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89102.

The wells were constructed using 4-inch PVC pipe and screen to a depth of 25 feet below the ground surface. The wells are located in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 20 South, Range 61 East, Clark County, Nevada. The wells are located on property whose address is 1100 North Main Street.

On June 1, 1989, WTI destroyed the PVC pipe and screen by drilling through it with a 5 1/8 inch tricone bit using a rotary-air drilling rig. Neat cement was then placed in the
