Subsequent to a recent telephone conversation between you and our staff, SECOR International, Inc. (SECOR) is submitting the enclosed notification of a destroyed monitoring well on behalf of its client, 7-Eleven, Inc. (7-Eleven).

The subject groundwater monitoring well (SMW-1) was located at 2800 North Las Vegas Boulevard (Parcel No. 139-137-702-001) in the ^{NE-SW} ~~NW~~ quarter of the ~~SE~~ quarter of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 61 East. The well was located on a property adjacent to the above-referenced 7-Eleven Store 19653, where several monitoring wells are being used for ongoing monitoring and remediation activities. During recent construction activities at the site, the subject well was either buried and/or potentially destroyed. SECOR has attempted to locate the well without any success. Please accept the enclosed notification that the groundwater well will no longer be used and is assumed to be destroyed.
