Gentlemen:

This letter will document the activities associated with the abandonment of five monitoring wells located at the former "Elardi" site located on the northeast corner of the Paradise Road and Swenson Street intersection, in Clark County, Nevada. The work was conducted by Converse Environmental Consultants, Southwest, Inc. (CECSW) in accordance with our proposal dated April 25, 1991, and your approval on April 29, 1991.

Four of the five wells were in a six-inch boring, 30 to 40 feet in depth, with a 2 inch diameter casing. The fifth well was in an eight-inch boring, approximately 30 feet in depth, with a 4 inch diameter casing. The casing, for all five wells, was sealed with bentonite and grouted with neat cement to the surface. The wells were in good condition and still functional. They were used to measure water levels and for collecting water samples. The wells were plugged and abandoned because the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection indicated that they required no further monitoring at the subject site.

The wells were plugged and abandoned in accordance with the requirements of the State Engineer, Nevada Division of Water Resources in accordance with provisions of NAC 534.420. Abandonment began on May 1, 1991, under the supervision of Mr. Don Wilson (License No. M1589). The casing was removed, from all wells, using a drill rig. Upon removal of the casing, the wells were redrilled to their original depth. On May 7, 1991, all five wells were grouted to the surface using neat cement (see Drawing No. 1).

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



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
