


Gentlemen:

This letter is to inform you of the plugging process of the well located on the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Sec 11, T19N, R20E in Washoe County, Assessors parcel # 37-271-25. On Wednesday, July 3, we set up on the hole and perforated the casing with a wheel cut perforator. This places a 3/16" to 1/4" cut in the casing. These cuts were placed eight times around the diameter of the casing beginning at 1' below ground level and continuing to 50 feet below the surface. On Friday July 5, we entered into the hole with our drill pipe. The well was found to be a depth of 170'. We circulated mud in the hole for thirty minutes at a viscosity of 70 and weight of 9 1/2 lbs. We then placed a plug in the hole at 55'. We pumped neat cement from this depth up to 1' below surface. This took 34 bags of cement mixed with 6 gallons water per bag. The casing was cut 1' below surface level and the hole was covered with native material. This was the completion of the abandonment process for this well.
