

Gentlemen:

This letter is to inform you of the plugging process of the well located on the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Sec 26, T13N, R20E in Douglas County, permit #55356. On Tuesday April 9, we set up on the hole and perforated the casing with a turtle back perforator. This places a 3/8" cut in the casing, two cuts per application. These were placed from two feet below the surface to 50 feet below the surface, placed every foot, four times around. On Thursday April 11, we entered into the hole with our drill pipe. The well was found to be a depth of 120'. We circulated mud in the hole for thirty minutes at a viscosity of 70 and weight of 9 1/2 lbs. We then placed a plug in the hole at 52'. We pumped neat cement from this depth up to 1' below surface. This took 81 bags of cement mixed with 6 gallons water per bag. On Friday April 12, the cement had gone out into the formation and lowered to a depth of 12' below surface. We mixed 12 more bags of neat cement bringing the cement level to 6" below surface. This was the completion of the abandonment.
