At the request of Pat Mooney from Eddco Exploration, Inc., I am writing you this letter to offer a brief description of the conditions relating to the capping-off of our old well. The property location to which I am referring is 381 Genoa Ln., Genoa, NV A.P.N. # 17-130-07 the S.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 ~~Sec. 10 Township 13 N. Range 19E~~ Douglas Co. I had scheduled Pat to drill us a new deeper well and cap-off our existing as we were flooded during the "New Years Flood" resulting in a contaminated well. We were also in the process of remodeling our house to reduce the risk of flood in the future. As it turns out our old well casing wound up smack dab in the center of our new foundation. In order to keep construction on schedule and to pass Douglas County inspection we filled the well from the bottom up with neat cement and then poured our concrete foundation around it. The result was a completely filled well casing (which was only 50 feet deep) and a solid foundation for the home. Your understanding is sincerely appreciated.
